NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS

Subject: Update on GM-LIBCOM Welfare Contributions

Dear Members,

Following a meeting with the representatives of three of the founding organisations of GM-LIBCOM—***Koukaipai Women Organisation, Manchester Mandingo Community, and Manchester Men Community***—the representatives unanimously agreed that all financial welfare contributions relating to bereavements and other welfare matters should remain the responsibility of the respective founding organisation to which the affected member belongs.

The representatives explained that each founding organisation already has an established welfare policy and support system for assisting its members during times of bereavement and other welfare-related situations. They further recommended that GM-LIBCOM's role in welfare matters should focus on providing moral and social support through phone calls, visitations, and other appropriate expressions of solidarity.

After careful consideration, the Leadership and the Welfare Committee have resolved to respect and implement the unanimous decision of the representatives of the three founding organisations. Any future review or proposed changes to this welfare arrangement will be referred to the Board for consideration and guidance.

Accordingly, we wish to inform all members that GM-LIBCOM's financial welfare contributions are suspended with immediate effect until further notice.

With regard to the welfare contributions that were recently collected, the Leadership, through the Welfare Committee, has agreed that all monies received will be refunded in full. As these funds were donated specifically for welfare purposes, the leadership believes it would not be appropriate to redirect them to any other purpose without the consent of those who contributed.

The reimbursement process will commence immediately. For the sake of transparency and accountability, a complete record of all refunds received will be shared with the membership.

Finally, we extend our heartfelt appreciation to every member who willingly and generously contributed when called upon. Your kindness, compassion, and unwavering commitment to supporting fellow Liberians demonstrate the values upon which our community continues to grow.
